All threats to our school and students are taken seriously and investigated thoroughly. Terroristic threats are considered Class A student conduct offenses. Penalties can range from detention to dismissal with the possibility of arrest and serious criminal charges. I encourage our parents to speak with their child(ren) about making the right choices and the potential consequences of their actions.
