

Niu Valley Middle School Dress Code Policy

- Uniforms shall be worn when on campus including before and after school.
- No writing on and no alterations (e.g. cutting, shredding) of uniforms.
- Shorts/skirts shall be no shorter than your fingertips when arms are extended to the side.
- Jeans/pants shall not have holes or tears in them at all. No ripped jeans
- PE uniform pants are acceptable to wear during the school day.
- No bandanas or headwear without brim. No hats allowed indoors.
- No items of clothing or accessories that promote unacceptable behaviors and/or illicit drugs/substances.

School Uniform Description

- School ID must be worn at all times.
 - Keep your ID in good condition. If it becomes defaced, damaged or lost, you will be required to purchase a new ID (\$5.00 charge applies).
 - Your ID is for your use. Do not lend your ID to any student for any reason.
- Shorts, skirts, pants that conform to length requirements.
- Footwear required.
