Criteria for Returning to School for <u>Someone Who Tests Positive for COVID-19</u> (Must meet ALL three criteria)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At least 10 calendar days have passed since symptoms first appeared or if there are no symptoms; at least 10 days have passed since the date when the positive test was conducted. • At least 24 hours have passed since last fever without the use of medication. • Symptoms have improved.

Once complete, your child is then required to report to the office with the completed Return to Campus Criteria form. The office will issue the student an admit slip which is to be turned to their first period of the day teacher.

As a reminder, the following five mitigating factors are to ensure the health and safety of our school community.

- Wearing of face masks

- Personal hygiene and handwashing
- Cleaning and disinfecting
