FAQ

- When is the permission slip due?
 - Deadline to turn in permission slip - **3pm on Friday, 11/3**. Slips can be returned to Mr. Fanning in the Band Room, to the ILC or to the office.
- Will there be a cap on admission?
 - No. All students who turn in a permission slip by the deadline and show up with an ID will be allowed into the premises. There will, however, be a cap on the number of people INSIDE the cafeteria due to fire-hazard capacity (300). Once we hit the 300 capacity in the cafeteria, we'll form a line for entry (just like a nightclub). When X number of kids come out, X number of kids in the line can go in.
- Will there be anything for the kids waiting outside to do?
 - There will be food concessions, glowsticks for sale and a photobooth.
- What if my child lost their ID?
 - They can pay for a new ID in the office. The cut-off for ID purchases is Thursday, November 9th at 12pm. You will not be able to purchase a new ID at the dance.
- My child is going to be late because they have another activity after-school. Is admittance cut off at a certain point?
 - No. If a student turned in a permission slip by the deadline and has their ID, they can check-in at any time.
- What time is pick-up?
 - 8:30pm
- Is my student allowed to walk-home?
 - No. All students must be picked up by a parent or guardian.
- Where is drop-off and pick-up?
 - Both are inside the parking lot; there will be no drop-offs or pick-ups allowed at the statues.
