

You can use text- or voice-chat to communicate with your tutor in the online classroom. You and your tutor may also use the interactive whiteboard to share work and ideas.


All activity in the classroom is recorded for review and quality control. Transcripts will be available afterward in **My Account** under the **Completed Sessions** tab.


Step 5: Rate and review your session


Use special tools
